JUDGING TO TAKE PLACE IN THE FIELD.

SHOW RULES

- 1) The Show committee and / or the Landowner will not be held responsible for any accidents, damage, loss or injury to any Person, Exhibit or Property on the Show Field.
- 2) Entries are confined to a 10 mile radius from the Show Field to farmstead, excepting dogs and horse section which are open. Local classes confined to the parish of Llanddewi Brefi and to all members of Llanddewi Brefi W.I., Llanddewi Brefi Primary School, Young Farmers Club and Youth Club.
- 3) The decisions of the Judges and the Committee are final.
- 4) Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary within ½ hour of the class being judged and accompanied by £5. The decision of the Committee is final.
- 5) Sheep section only.
 - a) During judging only stewards and Judges shall be allowed in the ring.
 - b) Stewards should make every effort to avoid catching their own animal.
- 6) No stalls, stands or trading will be allowed without the permission of the Committee.
- 7) Stewards are not allowed to lead their animals with their badges on in the ring.
- 8) All dogs must be kept on lead and a dog docked may NOT be entered for exhibiting at this show.
- 9) All Challenge Cups to be signed for and returned to the Secretary by August 1st of the following year.
- 10) There will be no separate section for Maedi Visna and EBL.
- 11) All sheep exhibits must be returned to their pens and not to their transport after judging.
- 12) All stock exhibits must have been the property of the exhibitor for at least 3 months prior to the Show.
- 13) No exhibit to be removed before 4.00 p.m.
- 14) Everyone must pay at the entrance gate.
- 15) All sheep must be untrimmed during show year.
- 16) No more than 2 entries per class in Farm Produce Section. In the event of a tie the number of 1st prizes will be taken to consideration
- 17) Local Horses and sheep will be judged first.
- 18) Stallions not to be handled by a child under 16.
- 19) In the case of an animal deemed to be dangerous in the ring the handler will be asked to remove the exhibit from the ring.

- 4) Exhibitors must place under each exhibit a card with his / her name on one side. All cards will be supplied by the Stewards, and no others will be allowed.
- 5) All specimens exhibited must have been in the possession of the exhibitor at least one month before day of the Show. All Fruit and Flowers to be bona fide grown, and owned by the exhibitor.
- 6) All entries in the Handicrafts Section to be exhibitors own work.
- 7) Presentation of Awards and Silver cups for Horticultural Show at 3.00 p.m. prompt in the Hall.
- 8) The exhibition will open at 1.30 p.m. and will close at 4.00 p.m. No exhibits to be removed before 4.00 p.m. or prize will be forfeited. All exhibits to be cleared by 5 p.m. This rule will be strictly enforced.
- 9) Exhibitors allowed 2 entries only in classes 1 - 67 and 1 entry in classes 68 - 70
- 10) The most careful arrangements for the protection of the exhibits sent for exhibition will be made, but the Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- 11) Any objection should be made to the Secretary before 2.30 p.m. on day of Show with a written statement, plus a deposit of £2.00. Should any objection not be sustained the deposit will be forfeited.
- 12) The Committee will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident that any exhibitor or spectator may sustain.
- 13) The Horticultural Show is open to the Parish of Llanddewi Brefi, and to all Members of Llanddewi Brefi W.I., Llanddewi Brefi Primary School, Young Farmers Club, Youth Club, Friendship Club and Sunday School.
